

5EBI Broadcast Training - towards Certificate III in Media CUF 30107

This Broadcast Course covers the announcing and technical skills to present radio programs on 5EBI.
It leads to 4 units of the nationally accredited Certificate III in Media
It's fun and exciting so here's what to expect.

The Full Training Course runs for **10 weeks** plus Final Assessment time (**12 weeks total**)
1 lesson per week, of 2½ hours 7.00 – 9.30 on Wednesday nights **plus** practice time.

If you MISS a lesson, you **must** catch it up before the next lesson. **If you miss 2 lessons**, you will need to re-enroll for the next course. Fees are not refundable.

You need **an extra 1 – 1½ hours every week** for homework & studio practice. Your weekly homework assignment counts towards your assessment. You will have to **book a studio for practice in your own time**, between lessons.

Studio Test

One 'live to air' program (28 ½ minutes) planned and paneled by trainee and observed by an assessor

Broadcast Test

Complete written Broadcasting Test on Broadcast Law, Codes of Practice, Ethnic funding and 5EBI policies.
(This may be done in an interview with assessor)

When you have successfully completed all assessments you will receive

1. A 5EBI Certificate of Achievement and be able to present a program at 5EBI
2. A Statement of Attainment for these Units of a Certificate III in Media CUF30107
 - CUFRES201A Collect & Organise Information for Broadcast or Publication
 - CUSSOU202A Mix Sound in a Broadcasting Environment
 - CUECOR01C Manage Own Work and learning
 - CUFAIR201A Develop Techniques for Presenting Information on Radio
